This week a contract haulier needed three staples to close a head wound after falling whilst getting out of his cab.

Please use the poster at the end of UK News (or in the download section) to put up around your business – on noticeboards; on the back of toilet doors; next to the kettle; or where drivers can see them safely.

With a total of 8 TRIs recorded in September this was our highest number of major injuries in any month since November 2011.... we all have a responsibility to stop letting people get hurt in our business.

This is the number one priority above all else. Nothing is more important.

During August & September the Logistics Commercial Haulage Team delivered 5 Haulier Health & Safety Leadership workshops across the UK.

Buzz Off!



Some of you will have no doubt seen the recent news that **Asian Hornet** (a.k.a Yellow-legged hornet) *Vespa Velutina*, has been confirmed on the UK mainland for the first time with the discovery of workers in Gloucestershire on 20th September (shown **on right in image above** in comparison with our native European hornet *Vespa Crabro* on left). This species first arrived in France in 2004 from where it has spread rapidly across Europe. It is vital that this species does not become established in the UK and a rapid response is currently in place to locate and destroy nests around

the initial incursion site. In the interim APHA (Animal & Plant Health Agency) are asking everyone to **keep vigilant** for any further outbreaks.

Please can I ask that we all keep an eye out for this species and report any sightings (**including photos**) immediately either via email: alertnonnative@ceh.ac.uk or through the online reporting form: http://www.brc.ac.uk/risc/alert.php?species=asian hornet. Downloadable information including ID and alert posters are available via the links provided including how to separate from the native European hornet.

You can read more about the arrival of Asian Hornet on the RSPB's blog including the many benefits that our native bees and wasps bring to our natural ecosystems and why we shouldn't demonise a species for our own wrongdoings.

Advance Warning Of SAP Outage

ADVANCE WARNING There will be a short period when SAP will not be available between the evening of Friday 14th October and evening of Monday 17th October (exact times to be confirmed).

Who's affected? This will affect all CEMEX UK users of our SAP systems including Standard SAP, CRM, RMS Order Fulfilment and Easyquote - it is also affecting our operations in Germany, France and Poland.

Why's it happening? This is a vital upgrade to our current SAP version which is nine years old and difficult to support and develop. Moving to the latest SAP version will give us an improved platform, enabling us to maximise the use of latest SAP modules and technologies.

How's it being managed? Detailed plans are in place to manage the outage nationally and locally, and staff will be advised what they need to do before, during and after the outage.


