People Keep On Tripping Up....



Whilst there were no LTIs last week, at the end of the week there was a reported incident when a driver tripped and injured his lower back. It seems the driver parked his car first thing in the morning, before walking to the site dispatch office to get the keys for his lorry, when he apparently tripped on a kerb and injured his lower back in the resulting fall. A team has been established to investigate the incident and will consider a number of factors including the suitability of the walkway, the lighting in the area and the injured person's footwear.

If this incident is confirmed as a TRI it will be the fourth we have suffered in just over a month as a result of slips/trips/falls. In addition, it should be noted that two thirds of our slip/trip/fall incidents in the last 12 months have involved drivers.

It is essential we take action to stop this trend. Managers and Supervisors are encouraged to work with their teams to:

- Review pedestrian routes and ensure walkways are in a suitable condition and well lit.
- Pay particular attention to steps/stairways, changes in direction and areas where it is necessary to walk from one surface to another, e.g. concrete to steel, or where it is necessary to step up or down kerbs.
- Be reminded of the need to keep walkways clear and 'Get a Grip' on steps and stairways.
- Report any slip/trip/fall hazards via the Near Miss/Hazard Alert system.

New Do Not Disturb Feature On i-Phones



Last week Process & IT confirmed that CEMEX enrolled i-Phone users can install the latest software update, iOS 11.2.2. A "Do Not Disturb While Driving" feature has been included in this update which senses when you are driving and ensures the i-Phone stays silent and the screen stays dark.

If someone sends you a message they receive an automatic reply letting them know that you're driving. If the message is important, the sender can type the word "urgent" to make sure that you receive a notification so you can pull over

in a safe place to read their important message. Phone calls are delivered using the same conditions as standard "Do Not Disturb".

Carbon8 Service Back On Track



Congratulations and thank you to Mark Thompson and Mike Fowler for restoring customer, Carbon8's, faith in CEMEX by giving a superior customer experience. Carbon8 are an important customer for our Wickwar and Freeman's Quarries.



In a 'virtuous circle' we supply Carbon8 with limestone dust and APC from Freeman's Quarry, both slow moving stock. Carbon8 then use our Aggregate to

process 'air pollution control residue' and capture CO2. As a by-product they create a manufactured Aggregate.

We then collect this Aggregate and use it at Wickwar Quarry where we blend it with virgin material. This works as it increases our yield and profit margins, whilst preserving valuable virgin mineral. We collect approximately two loads of manufactured Aggregate for every one that goes in.

This arrangement is a win-win for us and the customer, and Mike and Mark have received praise from Craig Britton, Assistant Site Manager at the Carbon8 Aggs Plant in Avonmouth, for being clear and efficient and resolving previous frustrations with our service.

Manchester Going Great Guns



Central Manchester Plants hit the Volume Heights last week with near capacity volume being produced on a daily basis. Manchester Gorton and Altrincham Plant Managers deserve great credit for the hours worked to provide excellent customer service.

New Arrival In Liverpool – CEMEX Asphalt Plant



Last week Joe Anderson, Mayor of Liverpool, officially opened CEMEX UK's new Asphalt Plant in Liverpool's Docklands. This is the first CEMEX Asphalt Plant in the city and represents a total investment of approximately £4 million and over three years planning.
