Be Aware Of Slips, Trips And Falls



Please take extra care in the cold, slippery weather to avoid slips, trips and falls. We know from our history that this time of the year is the worst for slips, trips and falls.

Last week a contract truckmixer driver on one of our Concrete Plants in UK North suffered a cut to his head, which had to be cleaned and glued in hospital. The driver was getting out of his cab to do his truck checks and, as he stepped down to

the ground, his foot slipped on mud and he fell backwards, hitting his head on railings behind him.

An investigation is underway and a Safety Alert concerning the incident will be circulated. In the meantime, immediate action has been taken to ensure the trucks are parked in a more suitable position on site, with better ground conditions.

Cement TRI In Rugby



We are reporting the fourth week in a row (until 1st Feb) with Zero LTI in Europe Cement Operations for employees and contractors.

But we have to report a Medical Treatment Injury (TRI) in Rugby Cement Plant. A rope access contractor suffered a small cut above his eye, which had to be cleaned and glued in hospital. The contractor was working with colleagues during major shutdown to remove 50kg metal plates from inside the top of a cyclone, when three of the plates move down, with one striking his safety helmet; it is thought the impact on his integral

full-face visor caused the small cut.

It is likely that far more serious injury would have resulted if it was not for the planning of the high-risk work being carried out and the method of work selected, along with strict supervision. A Safety Alert will be shared to explain the full circumstances of the incident. Site teams will be asked to review this carefully to ensure suitable precautions are in place across all Cement Plants when similar activities are carried out.

Take Care Of Your Mental Health

Look Out For The Latest Video Safety Alert



We have seen an increase in reversing vehicle incidents since the start of the year, one of which is captured in our latest Video Safety Alert.

When reviewing the Alert with your teams and colleagues, please consider the following key points:

- Are all high potential incidents (HiPos) reported, logged in INTELEX and fully investigated so we can share any learning points and help prevent more serious incidents and injuries in the future? and
- Do the traffic management arrangements on your site(s) minimise the potential for incidents?... For example, are traffic routes and parking areas clear, is there adequate directional signage, are one way systems in operation, are vehicles parked so that the first movement is forwards, and are pedestrian routes physically segregated from vehicles wherever possible?

Further details on the requirements can be found in the CEMEX Health and Safety Management System and the Global Standards for the "Management of Traffic on CEMEX Premises" and "Safe Reversing".

Brexit Contingency Plan



As we see in the daily news, there is significant uncertainty about the future direction of the UK economy as a result of the Brexit negotiations. There is also growing uncertainty amongst business leaders and analysts about likely negative impacts on the economy and the construction sector. This in turn could lead to reduced demand for our products leading up to and following 29th March, the date when the UK is scheduled to leave the EU.

For these reasons we have formed a UK Brexit Contingency Committee to ensure we are prepared for any negative impact on our 2019 budget. All relevant areas of the business are represented on the Committee, and it is being coordinated by the Europe Risk Management team.

Why Do We Need a CEMEX UK Brexit Contingency Plan?

Whenever our business is faced with potential threats to our volumes and income such as now, it is important that we analyse the risks and take prudent and proportionate steps to mitigate negative impacts as early as possible.

Whilst we are now CEMEX Europe, any negative Brexit impact will primarily affect our UK markets and operations. As described above, we need to be ready in the event of a No Deal Brexit, such that our business is prepared if UK construction output is negatively impacted.

What Are the Mitigation Measures in our Contingency Plan?

For all businesses and functions - Since 1st January 2019 our management teams are working on mitigation measures such as revised expenditure authorisation levels, approvals for new appointments, maintenance and operations costs review, temporary labour, improvement projects and travel and expenses.

For Supply Chain and Procurement – our Supply Chain will be reviewed to ensure we are sourcing from the optimum locations for best cost and imports timing. **Procurement** will postpone price increases to suppliers – this may cause some disruption but please collaborate with them to deliver the savings wherever possible.

Capital Expenditure Projects

There will be a review of 2019 capex proposals and a strict prioritisation plan.

Hopefully the above is clear – if not please speak to your Line Manager. It is important that everyone recognises the highly unusual current period of economic and political uncertainty, and that this is a sensible and prudent plan to help us maintain our 2019 business performance as far as possible.

Final Thought – Everyone needs to adopt the mindset that in Q1 discretionary expenditure should not be made - "*if safe operation does not require it immediately then don't spend it*".

Go Loco For Cocoa And Save A Rainforest



It's not often that your guilty pleasures can help protect a rainforest – but the RSPB's chocolate bar does just that! Gola Rainforest Chocolate is the ultimate nature-friendly chocolate bar, made from forest-friendly cocoa beans grown in the depths of the Gola rainforest in Sierra Leone.

Like palm oil, large areas of tropical forest are cleared to make way for commodities such as cocoa to meet demand across the world. But it doesn't have to be this way. Cocoa grows best when surrounded by the shade of the other trees, the rainforest itself protecting the cocoa from the harsh sun and providing nutrients through the soil.

Gola Forest is a biodiversity hotspot and home to many endangered species including pygmy hippos, forest elephants and chimpanzees – as well as more than 300 bird and 600 butterfly species. The farmers live outside the park and grow the cocoa amongst native forest trees, on land which they also manage in harmony with the wildlife. Selling these beans help them to build a profitable business without the need to encroach on the rainforest.

Because the beans are high quality and forest-friendly, the farmers can sell them for a premium as a reward for their role in protecting the rainforest and its unique biodiversity. The harvested beans are then sent to Cornish chocolate maker Chocolarder where they are slow roasted to create both a delicious dark and milk bar, with naturally rich and fudgy flavours.

All profits from the sales of these chocolate bars will be reinvested into the Gola Rainforest Cocoa Forest and continue to protect Sierra Leone's threatened wildlife and support local communities. Gola Rainforest Chocolate can be bought from the RSPB online shop or from RSPB reserve shops.
