Address Any Outstanding Issues



In the UK it is a concern to think that at the beginning of this month we had over 500 overdue corrective actions from Health and Safety Inspections and 65 Near Miss/Hazard Alerts that have been open over three months, any of these items could potentially lead to injury...

Site teams are asked to review and address any outstanding actions at the earliest opportunity, thereby helping ensure we Look After Ourselves and Each Other.

Take Care Around Moving Machinery



The concerning run of serious injuries across the Region continues, with an incident last week in Spain where an employee suffered severe trauma to four fingers of one hand, when they came in to contact with the drive belts for a conveyor. It seems the employee gripped the guard as he accessed the conveyor walkway, however, there was no protection at the back of the guard.

The employee will be in hospital for at least three months as he recovers from his injuries.

This is the second incident in the Region where an employee has suffered very serious injury as a result of contact with moving machinery in less than two months, which is simply unacceptable. If we are to avoid further serious injuries and potentially fatal incidents, Operations must take action to ensure guarding and isolation arrangements meet the CEMEX Global Standards as a matter of urgency. In this particular instance the drive belts should have been fully enclosed.



CEMEX Participates In Reconstruction Project In Puerto Rico



CEMEX announced today that it actively participated in the reconstruction of the Guajataca Reservoir in Puerto Rico, which suffered significant structural damage in the wake of Hurricane María in September 2017.

When Hurricane María entered Puerto Rico as a Category 4 storm two years ago, sustained winds of approximately 250 kilometres per hour caused estimated damages of approximately US\$100 billion, left the

entire island without electricity, and broke the spillway of this important reservoir. The break was one of the most alarming issues that was addressed during this emergency, given the importance of this infrastructure for the entire island.

The project was carried out by the Del Valle Group construction company, at the request of the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority and the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and CEMEX supplied the more than 15,000 cubic metres of concrete required to rebuild this crucial reservoir, (this amount is equivalent to approximately 20,000 cubic yards, from which approximately 17,000 cubic yards were of high strength fluid concrete and 3,000 cubic yards of structural concrete).

CEMEX Will Recognise World-Class Projects



The 2019 International CEMEX Building Awards will feature 32 projects from 14 countries.

The 32 finalists were recently announced for the competition that recognises the best and most innovative construction projects worldwide.

This year's award will feature 14 countries: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, Spain, France, Mexico, Montenegro, Panama, Poland, Puerto Rico, the Czech Republic, the Dominican Republic, and the United Kingdom.

The CEMEX Building Awards are one of the most recognised competitions in the construction industry, fostering a culture of sustainability and innovation by recognising projects and professionals who are leading the way to new and better industry practices.

The International Award is divided into five categories: Residential Housing, Economic Housing, Building, Collective Space, and Infrastructure. It also has four special awards: Universal Accessibility, Innovation in Construction, Social Value, and Sustainable Building.

Some of the representative projects are the Palacio de Congresos and the Hotel Palma de Mallorca in Spain; the Water and Light Pavement in France; and the Finca La Caja School in Costa Rica, among others.

The jury that determined the winners was made up of 16 judges with extensive experience in the construction sector from six different countries: Mexico, Puerto Rico, Colombia, the United States, Panama, and the Dominican Republic. The awards ceremony will be held in Mexico City on 7th November 2019, after announcing the winners of the Mexico Edition.

The Mexican sculptor, Miguel Ángel González, created the statuette that is presented to the winners. Combining black marble and concrete, the award's inspiration comes from humans' transformation of the materials at their disposal into elements of architectural, construction, and design expression.
