Cement Logistics Scoop Safety Sword 2020




Thank you Sergio Mauricio Menendez Medina for presenting the UK Safety Sword to David Hart last week.

Be Salt Aware - 5g A Day



Too much salt is bad for your blood pressure and increases your risk of having a stroke. For adults it is recommended that we only have 5g a day – about one teaspoon. Remember to check food labels for hidden salt. For example, an M&S American pepperoni pizza



(395g) has 5.46g of salt in – the equivalent of 11 bags of Walkers crisps - which is your daily intake plus some, in several easy mouthfuls!

To help keep our hearts healthy we need to keep our blood pressure down. So, we have produced a couple of posters at the end of this document for your messrooms and offices to spread the word about salt.

Here's some more top tips to 5 grams:

- Check food labels before you buy
- Use herbs and spices, garlic and citrus to flavour your food instead of salt
- Take salt and salty sauces off the table so you break the salt habit
- Gradually add less salt to your food so your taste buds adjust to less
- Drain and rinse canned vegetables and beans eat more fresh veg and fruit instead

Global Safety Alert About Vehicle Rollovers



An apparent increase in the frequency of vehicle rollovers prompted a review of related incident trends across CEMEX worldwide. The result of this review is summarised in a safety Alert. This highlights that there have been 14 fatal incidents in the last seven years resulting from vehicle rollovers, with 59 vehicle rollovers in 2019 alone; the majority of these incidents have involved contract Drivers, with truckmixers and Cement bag trucks being at particular risk.

These statistics are deeply concerning and highlight the need to ensure driver competency, through effective assessment and approval processes, robust inductions, ongoing training programmes, including defensive driver training, and monitoring, including ride along VFLs.

Where operations engage with Drivers, please review this Alert with both employee and Contract Drivers, discussing what can be done to minimise the risks and reminding them to drive in accordance with road and weather conditions, and the load and vehicle limitations.

In addition, it would be timely to double check that all truckmixer drivers have seen the training pack which was circulated last year to raise awareness of the risk of vehicle overturns.


30 Years For Carl Platt

Coronavirus Update For UK Employees



Overview and Status in UK

The number of people affected by the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak has reached 88,948 cases worldwide, with 2,135 cases in Europe. As of today, the number of cases in the UK is 40. Yesterday, the EU raised the Coronavirus threat level to "High".

Accordingly, we are implementing the following measures in all our European operations:

Business Travel

- Travel Ban to high risk areas (China, South Korea, Northern Italy, Japan, Hong Kong, and Iran).
- Postpone all new non-essential international air and international train travel for business in CEMEX Europe for the next 14 days from today (the situation will be reviewed by the end of this 14 day period).
 - Note: Travel authorisation routes are not changed, we are just restricting international business travel to essential business travel only. Travel must still be authorized in line with current rules - requiring authorization by the relevant VP.
- If you need to travel internationally for an essential business purpose, please confirm this with your Line Manager.
- If you are already abroad now, continue with your existing travel plans regarding return to your home country.
- If you have travelled to a high risk area for business or personal reasons, inform your Line Manager, and remain at home for the next 14 days following the return date. If any symptoms develop, please call NHS 111 and inform your Line Manager.

Hygiene and Preventative Measures

- Promote personal hygiene and always clean your hands with soap or with alcohol-based hand rub.
- Be vigilant and avoid close contact (under 2 metres) with anyone who has cold or flu-like symptoms.

- Operational Site Managers are advised to provide hand sanitisers and disinfectant wipes as appropriate – masks should already be available on site but are not recommended for use by healthy individuals.
- Remember there is no cause for concern unless you have travelled to a risk area or you have been in contact or close proximity to someone who has confirmed Coronavirus.

If you do not have Coronavirus symptoms (fever, shortness of breath, coughing) continue your regular routine at home and in the office.

What to do if you have Flu-Like Symptoms

- Do not go to work and communicate your situation quickly to your Manager. Remain at home for self-monitoring.
- Make a risk self-evaluation. Consider if you have been to a potential risk area or if you could have been in contact with a potential risk person.
- Wear a face mask to reduce the risk of human-to-human transmission. Do not share cutlery or dinnerware, minimise physical contact.
- Consider enhancing hygienic measures. Dispose of tissues immediately after use, increase hand washing and avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Contact NHS 111 and inform them about your symptoms and your self-evaluation. Visit: https://111.nhs.uk/service/covid-19 for more information.

Impact at CEMEX

Currently, no CEMEX employee cases have been reported. Local Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) continue to be activated throughout CEMEX operations, and each country is implementing preventive measures accordingly. Our CEMEX Human Resources, Enterprise Risk Management and Global Security areas will continue to closely monitor the situation regarding new developments.

We will share regular updates on the virus and any action required by employees.

GLOBAL SAFETY ALERT

14 FATALITIES AS A RESULT OF ROLLOVERS IN PAST 7 YEARS

INCIDENT DETAILS

Sadly, over the past 7 years, 14 people lost their life as a result of truck rollovers and all but one of these incidents involved our contractors. Furthermore, 59 rollovers occurred in 2019 (70% contractors) with most incidents involving readymix trucks (23) and cement bag truck (23). These 59 incidents resulted in 2 fatalities, 4 LTI's and a further 4 TRI's

MANAGERS - KEY POINTS TO CHECK


- All drivers, including contractors, receive defensive driving and the prevention of rollovers training
- VFL 'drive along' activities are carried out to help influence safe driving behaviours
- Drivers are assessed/approved before working for CEMEX
- Vehicles are subject to regular servicing/maintenance and pre-start checks are in place with appropriate action taken
- · Effective journey planning processes are in place
- Drivers follow the CEMEX Policy for mobile phone use
- · Fatigue management procedures are strictly enforced

ALL PERSONNEL - ACTION TO TAKE


- Adjust your speed to the road layout and conditions never drive too fast & reduce speed to a safe level when approaching a curve in the road
- · Always use your seat belt, It can save your life!
- · Never drive tired stop in a safe place to rest if needed
- Be aware of the type and size of load being transported as this may affect the truck stability
- · Adhere to local requirements for weight limits on vehicles
- Understand the CEMEX Policy for mobile phone use the requirements are there for the safety of you and others who may be affected by your actions
- Plan your journey, especially long distances and know where safe rest places are located




