UPDATE

National Technical Centre Produces Hand Sanitiser For UK Sites



CEMEX is now able to produce hand sanitiser that can help prevent the spread of COVID-19 at its National Technical Centre in Southam. Creating this hand sanitiser, which has been made to the World Health Organisation's specifications, was the first task of the newly formed LabExperts operation.

This means that the LabExperts team can ensure enough hand sanitiser is available for all CEMEX sites across the country, and also provides opportunities to support the local community (see our other story about charity support in this issue).

So far, the team have been able to deliver to more than 60 CEMEX locations nationwide.

Mike Higgins, Head of CEMEX LabExperts in the UK, explains: "We are perfectly set up for creating a central supply of hand sanitiser that can help both our employees and those in the local community. While the chemistry to manufacture this important product is not complex, you do need a controlled laboratory environment with the right equipment and the ability to test every batch.

We have a good supply of raw materials in place and are confident we will be able to manufacture as much hand sanitiser as the business needs while also making the most of opportunities to support the local community.

So far, we have supplied over 60 of our Readymix, Aggregates and Asphalt plants and Paving Solutions, Logistics, DSM and Cement operations. Our location also means we are perfectly placed to ensure a quick delivery to where the product is needed. We know how important it is to prevent the spread of the virus so all of the team are very proud to have this opportunity to help."

More Good Practice Guides Available For Use



The Health & Safety team have been working closely with colleagues across the business to create more Good Practice Guides for employees to refer to when operating.

In particular, a guide about Social Distancing has been added, which refers to the requirement for a risk assessed approach where we may have a task in the workplace where social/physical distancing requirements may be compromised.

The first consideration in the hierarchy of control measures is to consider whether the task has to go ahead and, if it does, then formal authorisation and strict control measures are required. The overall philosophy is that if an activity cannot be undertaken safely, it should not take place. This has been written so that it aligns with the Construction Leadership Council Guidelines.

Furthermore, a video showing cab cleaning has been added, plus a useful document from Mark Beagrie which details some of the improvement ideas and activity from within the Materials team.


Dean from Calder CAD commented that the service was: "seamless... you wouldn't know that the Planners were at home and the team remained professional at all times."

CEMEX Report 2% Growth In Sales, Reaching US\$3.1 Billion



CEMEX recently announced that, on a like-to-like basis for ongoing operations and adjusting for currency fluctuations, consolidated net sales increased 2% during the first quarter of 2020 to US\$3.1 billion versus the comparable period in 2019. Operating EBITDA, also on a like-to-like basis, increased 1% during the first quarter of 2020 to US\$534 million.
