Update On Offices



The working group overseeing the return to offices is meeting weekly to ensure our office locations are ready when it is safe and appropriate for people to return. Audits have been completed of most of our UK offices to determine what new processes and equipment are needed to adapt the environment to meet Government guidelines.

The group met with the floor heads and team leaders for the Rugby office to talk them through the changes that will need to happen to the way people use the site – including a decluttering of all floors,

which is beginning with the fourth floor today and will take several weeks.

At this stage, the aspects of our business that are being run remotely are performing well and meeting current demand levels. There is no urgent need for any of our teams to return to the offices and all of our action is being driven by Government guidelines — a return will not happen unless the Government says it is safe to do so. There is a lot more work still to be done before any of our office locations can be used so all employees must continue to work remotely unless advised otherwise by the RRT. It will be some time yet before any of the offices are ready for a return, and when they are, the new normal will be very different to the office environment we were all used to before lockdown.

Better. By A Distance.



CEMEX has identified key products which can help its customers to continue operations whilst meeting the challenges posed by current site working requirements.

Products that can reduce the use of additional materials and equipment and working in confined spaces, while allowing effective use of labour and maintaining physical distance guidelines are likely to be of increased demand as construction resumes.

Options from CEMEX to support these requirements include high performance concrete solutions, mortars and its digital platform CEMEX Go.

For example, Evolution™, CEMEX's self-compacting concrete range, which can spread into place, fill formwork, and encapsulate even the most

congested reinforcement by means of its own weight, with little or no vibration.

Additionally, the Advanced fibre reinforced concretes, a range of fibre reinforced ready-mix concretes, containing a blend of polypropylene micro fibres and engineered macro fibre or steel fibre solutions.

There are many features of fibre reinforced concrete, however the main one is the reduction or elimination of crack control steel mesh. This provides a number of benefits, including a reduction in material delivered, stored and handled on site and the minimisation of labour required for cutting and placing steel reinforcement.

Rapid hardening concrete, such as CEMEX's Promptis, can also help save valuable time during construction. Promptis has similar characteristics to conventional concrete but it can reach accelerated early strength after just six hours while still maintaining initial flow properties and consistence for up to 120 minutes. Formwork can be stripped after only six hours (subject to mix design and guidance). Benefits of this type of product include increased productivity, cost savings and removal of on-site delays.

Meanwhile, CEMEX's factory produced mortars offer clean, efficient production with reduced wastage and increased productivity on site. CEMEX can provide dry mortar in a silo, ready-to-use wet mortar and dry bagged mortar, meaning there is a solution available whatever the size of the site or requirements of the job. The dry silo systems also reduce manual handling and the risk of injury in production, for improved health and safety.

Finally, the CEMEX Go digital platform allows customers to easily order online, whatever their location. This means they can manage their account quickly and efficiently, including tracking deliveries, receiving digital invoices, placing and amending orders, without having to be in the office.

CEMEX Surpasses Supply Milestone In Upgrade Of Central Florida's Main Highway



CEMEX announced recently that it has passed a supply milestone for the I-4 Ultimate Improvement Project, delivering more than one-third of the ready-mix concrete required for the 21-mile (almost 34 kilometres) upgrade of Interstate 4, the main highway stretching through Orlando and Central Florida.

Construction crews began working on the \$2.3 billion transformation of I-4 in 2016, and over the last four years, CEMEX has supplied nearly

250,000 cubic yards (approximately 190,000 cubic metres) of concrete of the total 620,000 cubic yards (approximately 474,000 cubic metres) for the project. CEMEX is expected to supply at least 375,000 cubic yards (approximately 287,000 cubic metres) of concrete over the life of the I-4 Ultimate Improvement Project.

Over the last few weeks, the COVID-19 pandemic led to a decrease in traffic in Central Florida, and crews were able to accelerate construction. With the increased access, crews finished five new flyovers at the I-4/State Road 408 interchange early, leading to them opening three months ahead of schedule. CEMEX supplied 58,000 cubic yards (approximately 44,000 cubic metres) of concrete for the new flyovers.

The entire I-4 Ultimate Improvement Project is expected to upgrade the interstate built in the 1960s to current industry standards while better accommodating the number of vehicles that utilise the highway today. The project is currently scheduled to be completed in 2021.

Environmental Partnership With Newport City Council



We have entered into a partnership with Newport City
Council (NCC) who are now acting as the Primary Authority
(PA) for CEMEX sites in Wales. This mirrors the
partnership with have with Worcester Regulatory Services
(WRS) for CEMEX sites in England. We are regulated by
several local authorities across Wales for Pollution
Prevention & Control and Environmental Protection.

The PA partnership with NCC has enabled us to form a legally recognised partnership with a single local authority in Wales. This will provide us with robust, consistent and reliable regulatory advice which other local authorities in Wales must take into account in their dealings with us.

In this way, PA promotes fairness in the way that regulations are enforced locally. NCC and WRS are working together to also enable consistency across England and Wales. A different regulatory regime operates in Scotland with SEPA being the single regulator responsible for all sites in Scotland.
