Updates to Travel Corridors

Yesterday some further changes were made to countries on the UK travel corridors list. People arriving in the UK from **Denmark, Iceland, Curaçao and Slovakia** from 4am Saturday 26 September 2020 will need to self-isolate for 2 weeks.

Flu Vaccine – Reminder

Public Health England has highlighted that the national flu immunisation programme will be absolutely essential to protecting vulnerable people and supporting the resilience of the health and care system over the winter months. Some employees will be able to receive a vaccine for free on the NHS, because they are deemed to be 'at risk' – for instance those who are pregnant, aged 65 years or older, or have certain medical conditions.
