Reminder: COVID Vaccine Bookable Online For All Over 55

We wanted to remind employees that you can book your Covid vaccines online if you are eligible to do so, even if you have not received a letter/text message from your GP.

As of Monday 8th March, all those over the age of 55 in England are now able to book a Covid vaccine as part of the continued expansion of the vaccine programme. Other people who are eligible include those who have a condition that puts them at higher risk or are a main carer for someone who is at high risk.

You can book an appointment online $\underline{\text{here}}$ – it is easy to do and will only take a few minutes to check if you are eligible.

We would encourage all those who are eligible to receive the vaccine to do so as this is a crucial part of our country's plan to move out of the pandemic; supporting vulnerable people, reducing the pressure on our NHS and ensuring that lockdown measures can ease and our economy can recover.
