
COVID-19 Update for UK Employees | 25/06/2021

COVID cases are rising again – please stay vigilant



As reported each day in the news, the number of UK COVID cases has **risen significantly in the last week** – positive tests up by >25k to >85k. The government's R-rate is 1.2 to 1.4 and trending negatively.

In CEMEX UK we had only two cases during May and early June, but **three in the last week**. One had not had the vaccine; however, the other two colleagues had received their first dose some weeks ago. In one of the cases specialist contractors from overseas are now having to self-isolate causing significant personal and business disruption.

Walk-In Vaccination Centres for Over-18s

This weekend, anyone aged 18 or over in England who has not yet had their first vaccination is encouraged to visit one of hundreds of walk-in centres – see the NHS list here -

Second jabs are also available at the walk-ins, if it has been at least eight weeks since the first dose for people aged over 40, and 12 weeks for people aged under 40. Even after vaccination it is still possible to catch the virus and pass on to others.
