

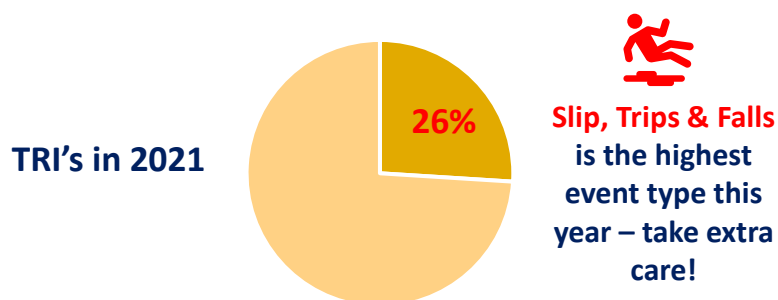
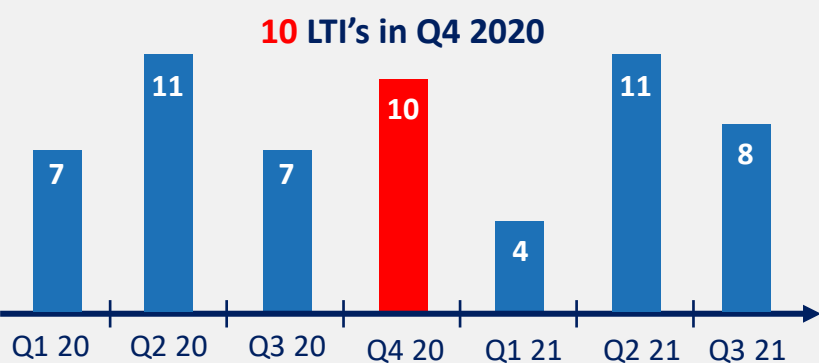

8 LTI's occurred between July – Sept this year, some resulting in severe injuries



Truck Rollover

Contracted readymix driver lost control on a road resulting a broken hand and shoulder



Eye Injury

Employee got fragments of a steel brush in his eye while using it to clean a concrete pipe

Shoulder Injury

Employee was struck by non-isolated machinery during maintenance

Fractured Leg

An employee was struck by equipment being moved by a crane

Fractured Ankles

Readymix driver slipped & fell on a slippery and wet surface on a CEMEX site

Readymix driver broke his ankle while standing on debris on a customer site

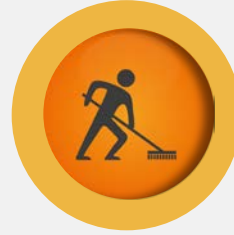
