MLP supported the CEMEX Rail Team with the summer improvements programme, which saw considerable investment into the Attercliffe, Bletchley and Small Heath depots. These were large projects which MLP completed

while ensuring high Health & Safety standards. Additionally, they carried out some pre-construction offsite (particularly for Attercliffe) to reduce outage and maintain customer supply.



Steve Taylor, Plant Manager at Attercliffe, commented: "MLP were an excellent contractor throughout the improvement programme at Attercliffe. They planned all the works out well, prioritising Health & Safety throughout, and this combined with their skillset and the top-notch machinery they used, meant they were very positive to work with.

CEMEX Supports Lancashire County Council with CarbonNeutral® Asphalt Product



CEMEX has worked with Lancashire County Council to provide a CarbonNeutral® Asphalt product for road surfacing in a residential area in Preston.

VIALOW Zero was selected by the Council for Cop Lane in Penwortham, Preston; a stretch of road with approximately 60 houses on it; and supplied by CEMEX's Liverpool Docklands asphalt plant.

Alongside the reduced carbon in the mix, the Council chose to offset the residual CO2e to make it a CarbonNeutral® product, in accordance with The CarbonNeutral® protocol. By offsetting the residual CO2e from the 310 tonnes of asphalt used for the project, 18 tonnes of CO2e was offset; the equivalent of the emissions generated by the annual electricity use for 25 homes.

Leslie Luxon, Asphalt Area Manager, commented: "Lancashire County Council and CEMEX have been partnered for some time, and the council have been early converts to the benefits of low temperature asphalts, which reduce their carbon footprint, improve durability, and pave the way to a greener Britain.

They are an ideal choice for councils and other customers looking to meet sustainability targets for their developments, while also offering many other benefits including improved safety, reduced downtime and easy application."

During the summer, CEMEX Birmingham embarked on supplying over 15,000m3 of high performance concrete to support the construction of the D wall at HS2 Bromford tunnel East Portal. Last week, exactly five months to the day, they supplied the final 220m3 of the 600mm flow, six hour flow retention and low bleed concrete for a significant section of this prestigious project.

Matt's in Honourable Company!




Congratulations to Matt Bland from our Marine Team who was presented with the Freedom of the City of London at the Guildhall last week.

The rates by engine type and size are outlined in the table below.

SAP Concur has been updated and claims for mileage from that date onwards will be made at the revised rates.
